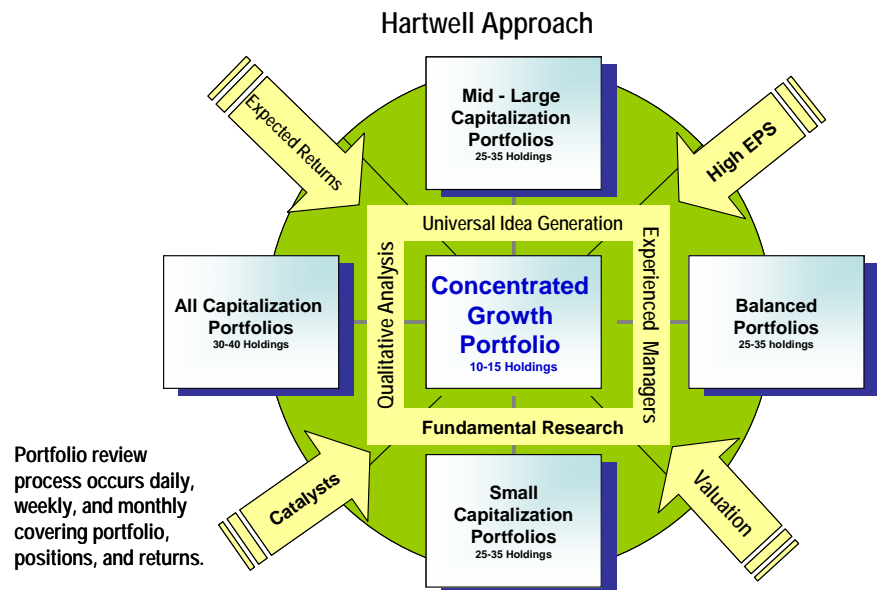
Maximize long-term total return over time by holding a concentrated "best ideas" portfolio of small, medium and large capitalization companies which are believed to possess significant potential for growth. The fund seeks a total return that exceeds the S&P 500 Composite index over time.

Investment Approach

There is a deliberate concentration upon a "few best ideas" and a Darwinian – "survival of the fittest" approach, refreshing the portfolio with the highest growth, most timely potential investments. The portfolio is constructed from the best 10-15 ideas generated by J.M. Hartwell L.P.'s collective research. The positions are prioritized by expected returns, the proximity of catalysts/events and compelling valuation levels.

New purchases precipitate sales, and an intolerance for losses enforces the sell discipline.

Stocks may be shorted to seek additional positive returns. No leverage is used in this strategy
